Kenya Universities and Colleges Central Placement Service (KUCCPS) is inviting applications for placement to various programmes offered in 266 Government Technical and Vocational Education and Training (TVET) Institutions for the May 2025 Intake.

The application is open to prospective trainees who sat the Kenya Certificate of Secondary Education (KCSE) examinations from the year 2000 to 2024.

Interested persons should log in to the KUCCPS Student's Portal students.kuccps.net and apply before **February 14, 2025**.

How to Apply

Log in to the KUCCPS Student's Portal students.kuccps.net and follow these steps.

1. Access the Student's Portal by typing the URL students.kuccps.net on your browser, or visit the KUCCPS website www.kuccps.ac.ke and click Student's Portal on the menu bar.
2. Click the **Login tab** and input your KCSE Index Number, KCSE Year and Password in the provided slots. Your password is your Birth Certificate Number or Your KCPE Index Number. Do not give your login details to anyone.
3. Once logged in, click **"Programmes"** to view available courses and their minimum requirements. You will only be able to apply for courses that you qualify for.
4. Once you have decided on your preferred courses, you will be required to enter the Programme Codes.
5. To apply, click the **"Application/Revision"** tab then **"Apply Now"**.
6. Enter the Programme Codes in the provided form, arranging them in your order of priority.
7. After entering the programme codes for the courses that you are applying for, click **Submit**.
8. You will be required to pay **Kshs. 1,500** and the portal will display the payment instructions. Follow the instructions.
9. After paying, enter the Payment Ref. in the provided slot and submit.

Your successful application will appear as **"Active Application"** on the Dashboard.
